Meeting Commenced at 1400

- 1. Administrative Remarks and Introductions (Col Shackelford):** Col Shackelford, the Chair of the Committee on Surgical Combat Casualty Care (CoSCCC), convened the meeting and welcomed participants. Mr. Dominick Sestito, Senior Administrative Assistant – JTS, took minutes.
- 2. Committee Information and Background (Col Shackelford):** Briefly discussed the year one deliverables of the CPG sub-committee.

Mary – What defines a Role 2. Maybe need to form capability based skill set/ equipment set (compartmentalized) based on
Ex. Head, Medical Emergency, Thoracic etc.

Stacy – That’s a great “next step” but first we need to produce an accurate list and break out Role 3 capabilities that are clearly “not Role 2” and are “Role 3 specific”

Donnell – How in-depth are we making these CPG’s – based on training of General Surgeon Level

Stacy – Any specific topics in CPG that need to be addressed? Think it will be best to break CPG into two parts

1. Surgeon
2. Non-surgeon

Katherine/Andrew – Agree topics need to address things like “type of incision ex. Clam shell etc.”

Stacy - Best to create an outline first and submit to this group for brainstorming/review and approval

Neuro topics – Appendectomy needs to be written to afford guidance to the CoC. The surgeon has lost the power of authority. Transport/ surgery is not “the surgeons call” anymore. CoC too involved on medical decisions without formal consistent guidance.

Deliverable – Acute Care Surgery
