What is Damage Control Resuscitation?

Damage Control Resuscitation (DCR) is a strategy that addresses life-threatening injuries through aggressive hemorrhage control and early blood transfusion near the point of injury.

Why is DCR important?

Uncontrolled hemorrhage is the **leading cause of preventable death** on the battlefield.



These guidelines help save lives on the battlefield and in hospitals.
