
What is Damage Control Resuscitation?

Damage Control Resuscitation (DCR) is a strategy that addresses life-threatening injuries

through aggressive hemorrhage control and early blood transfusion near the point of injury.

Why is DCR important?

Uncontrolled hemorrhage is the leading cause of preventable death on the battlefield.
