SUBJECT: Forward Resuscitative Care in Support of Dispersed Operations
DOTmLPP-P Change Recommendation

1. The Joint Requirements Oversight Council (JROC) reviewed the Forward Resuscitative Care (FRC) in Support of Dispersed Operations DOTmLPP-P Change Recommendation (DCR). The JROC approves the enclosed actions and recognizes the Office of the Joint Staff Surgeon as the lead organization for their implementation.
2. This DCR identifies gaps in the ability of the Department of Defense (DoD) to deliver and manage resuscitative care when operating in austere and remote environments. It presents a suite of integrated DOTmLPP-P solutions to mitigate the gaps.
3. The JROC requests that the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the Services, and the Combatant Commands implement actions as outlined in the enclosure. The JROC also requests that the Office of the Joint Staff Surgeon provide a FRC DCR semiannual update to the Health Readiness Working Group and an annual update to the Functional Capabilities Board managing the Health Readiness / Health Services Joint Capability Area.
